**S**tarting in their freshman year, qualified students will be eligible to take one or more of the **ten Honors** classes offered. Through an agreement with Columbia Union College (CUC), MVA will also offer classes which provide more than 30 semester hours of college credit. During their junior and senior years, our students will be able to take **Dual Credit** courses and receive both high school and college credit in that class. Naturally there will be higher academic requirements for enrollment in these classes, but students who take advantage of this program will be able to graduate from MVA having already completed up to one year of college. Parents will pay only 10 percent of tuition normally charged by CUC for these courses, and the academic credit earned may be used at CUC or transferred to nearly any other college or university.
